Since 2012, the National Museum in collaboration with the Department of Antiquities of the Ministry of Natural Resources and Tourism organizes a three-day cultural festival that also commemorates the hanging of Majimaji heroes in Songea town on February 27, 1906.

Mantra has been sponsoring and participating in this festival as part of its stakeholder engagement and relationship fostering and also because Ruvuma region and the Ministry of Natural Resources and Tourism (MNRT) are among Mantra's important stakeholders. The festival is commemorated from 25th to 27 February of each year.

Mantra uses the event to inform the public of its CSR activities, and uranium project development and educate the public on uranium and radioactive. Visiting Mantra's pavilion, the Regional Commissioner for Ruvuma, H.E. Bri. Gen. Wilbert Ibuge was briefed by Khadija Pallangyo, Mantra's Sustainability Manager on the company's CSR initiatives which focus on four key priority areas of health, education, environment, and sustainable projects. He commended Mantra's contribution to the region's development.

Commenting on Mantra's environmental projects that aim at reducing carbon print, the RC directed Mantra to collaborate with the Tanzania Forestry Services (TFS) and be advised on the suitable trees that need to be planted in specific areas.

H.E Brigadier General Ibuge said that the Government is on a nationwide plan to plant trees countrywide, at least 1.5 million per year, so they will move away from old-fashioned tree planting and instead, everyone should plant trees in a correct manner and style.

Mantra acknowledged it will use TFS in advising them in its tree planting exercises.

Some of the 130 houses that were destroyed by the rainstorm in Likuyusekamaganga Village, Namtumbo District, Ruvuma Region have been given the support of 410 sheets from Mantra Tanzania Limited a company that operates the Uranium mining project in the District.

Handing over the iron sheets to the District Commissioner of Namtumbo, Dr. Julius Ningu, Mantra Tanzania's Sustainability Manager Ms. Khadija Pallangyo said that the company has provided support for the roofing sheets worth Shs. 10 million following the request from the Namtumbo constituency representative Hon. Vita Kawawa who asked the company to help with the disaster.

The Sustainability Manager Pallangyo during the event said that the company has been working with the community, so it thought it would be good to give that assistance which will help some of the victims to return to their homes.

On his part, the Namtumbo District Commissioner, Dr. Julius Ningu while receiving the roofing sheets donation thanked the company and expressed that the Government recognizes the company's constant contribution to society.

Hon. Dr. Ningu said that various areas of the Villages in the District were affected by disasters, so the assistance will reach all those affected areas following a good procedure that will take into account the fact that the Government had provided help in some areas.

The disaster occurred on November 30, 2021, in the village at around 4:30 p.m., caused by 45 minutes of rain accompanied by strong winds and resulted in 130 houses being destroyed by the rain. This made the victims go to their colleagues whose homes were not wrecked by the storm.

The company that owns the Uranium Mining Project in the Namtumbo district of Ruvuma region, Mantra Tanzania Limited, has donated various construction items including roofing steels, nails, iron bars, and cement worth 7 million shillings to support construction activities in the Likuyuseka ward in the district.

Other donations given in the Likuyuseka ward are bags of cement, iron bars and aggregate for the construction of two classrooms at Likuyu village, also gave aggregate and transportation of construction materials for the mother and child center for Likuyu Mandela village. ## CSR AND SAFETY NEWS ROAD SAFETY AND GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE AWARENESS TRAINING LAUNCHED IN NAMTUMBO

Mantra Tanzania in collaboration with the Tanzania Police Force Road safety division in Namtumbo launched Road Safety and Gender Based Violence awareness programs for 18 primary schools and 5 secondary schools in Namtumbo. The Mantra-sponsored program was launched by the Acting Regional Transport Officer (RTO) Assistant Superintendent of Police (ASP) John Ntunde Namtumbo in October at Mtonya Primary School of Likuyu ward in Namtumbo district.

Since its inception in 2011, more than 16,000 pupils, students, and community members have benefited from road safety training. This program aims at sensitizing school children, motorcyclists, and the community at large on safe road practices hence reducing the number of accidents along the roads.

"Namtumbo economy is now booming, we are currently experiencing huge interactions due to growing economic activities, vehicles are massively increasing ever since the coal activities are up and running, Mantra's operations also moving in advanced stage therefore the roads are now busy.

With busy roads we need more precautions to reduce the number of safety incidents in our community" said Majani M. Wambura, Mantra's Sustainability Manager.

Reporting at the Launch, the Assistant District Transport Officer Police Inspector Kaunda Kaunda stated that from January – September 2021 there were 13 reported traffic violations compared to January 2022 where only 7 traffic violations are reported with a difference of 6 reported accidents, this positive impact is archived from such contractive initiatives from Mantra of ensuring the community is aware of the road risks and how to overcome them.

Addressing the community, ASP John Ntunde insisted that motorbikes have been the major cause of road accidents over the past few years. They have been very reckless and led to traffic rules violations.

"We have entrusted the motorcycle drives to pick up our children from one point to another, it is so unfortunate that they do not care and do not follow road signs which is a major cause of accidents, we need motorcyclists to be cautious and make sure you respect Zebra crossings, manage your speed and most important value your colleagues' right to life by adhering to road safety needs," said ASP Ntunde.

## MANTRA CONTRIBUTES TOWARDS THE IMPROVEMENT OF QUALITY EDUCATION IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN NAMTUMBO



Recently, Mantra Tanzania donated an electronic library to a public secondary school in Namtumbo. The e-library donation to Msindo Secondary School is an important milestone in the use of technology in learning in the district.

As part of its Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) program, Mantra has partnered with a Non-Governmental Organisation Read International to transform unused rooms in Namtumbo secondary schools into well-stocked libraries. The libraries are provided with various essentials such as basic training on library management, shelves, tables, seats, books, etc.

Mantra again went a step further by donating an electronic library to Msindo Secondary of Namtumbo District Council. Local artisans were used to remodeling an old classroom and making new bookshelves, desks, and tables. Five computers were installed and connected to the Internet in the library.

A special program with library functionality and an interface was developed and installed; electronic books and tutorials were uploaded to school web portals. Books are both scanned copies of printed books and stand-alone digital documents. In content, these are study guides and fiction in English and Swahili.

Using the resources of the electronic library, students will be able to read and watch materials on school subjects, teachers will be able to download and share information and plans for preparing lessons.

The computers at Msindo Secondary School are connected to the electronic libraries of other schools, so students and teachers have the opportunity to participate in online conferences and, finally, just chat.

The total cost of the project amounted to 32.2 million Tanzanian Shillings. In addition to the costs of the electronic library itself, this amount also included the purchase of print media to supplement the library stock.

By creating a functional and inspirational learning environment schools are provided with the tools for effective learning and promoting a culture of reading. In getting access to a library students read more, learn more, and get further in their studies.

The initiative has paved the way for students and teachers to have access to educational resources necessary for the development of a reading culture.

Handing over the e-library to Msindo Secondary school, the Sustainability Manager of Mantra Tanzania, Khadija Pallangyo said the company collaborates with the community in overcoming various development challenges within the community. She said Mantra will continue to complement the government's efforts in bringing development to the people.

Appreciating the donation, Chiriku Chilumba, Namtumbo District Executive Director said "Mantra had done something good to the school's youth by introducing them to the world of science and technology that would give them the opportunity to read online".



The Namtumbo District Executive Director who was the guest of honor said the district had 24 secondary schools and most had no better libraries except in seven schools that had also benefited from Mantra's donation so he asked the company to reach out to other schools to eliminate the shortage.

The headmaster of Msindo Secondary school, Henry Millanzi thanked Mantra and said "the modern e-library will definitely result in improved performance by 100% for students and teachers as they will have access to various online resources".

Tangu kuanzishwa kwa program hii mwaka 2011, zaidi ya wanafunzi 16,00 na wanajamii wamenufaika na elimu hii ya usalama barabarani. Programu hii inalenga kuwaelimisha wanafunzi, waendesha bodaboda na jamii kwa ujumla kuhusu matumizi salama ya barabara ili kupunguza ajali za barabarani.

"Uchumi wa Namtumbo sasa unakua, hivyo tunakabiliwa na mwingiliano mkubwa kutokana na kukua kwa shughuli za kiuchumi, magari yanaongezeka kwa kiasi kikubwa tangu shughuli za makaa ya mawe kuanza, shughuli za Mantra pia zinaendelea katika hatua ya juu kwa hiyo barabara sasa zina shughuli nyingi.

Kwa kuwa na vyombo vingi vya moto barabarani tunahitaji kuchukua tahadhari zaidi ili kupunguza idadi ya matukio ya hatari za kiusalama katika jamii yetu" alisema Majani M. Wambura, Meneja Uendeleu wa Mradi wa Mantra.

Akitoa taarifa katika Uzinduzi huo, Kaimu Afisa Usafiri wa Wilaya (DTO) Inspekta Kaunda Kaunda alisema kuwa kuanzia Januari - Septemba 2021 kulikuwa na matukio 13 ya ukiukwaji wa sheria za barabarani ikilinganishwa na Januari 2022 ambapo ni makosa 7 tu ya barabarani yameripotiwa na tofauti ya ajali 6 zilizoripotiwa. Matokeo chanya haya ni kutokana na msaada wa wadau wa maendeleo kama Mantra katika kuhakikisha jamii inafahamu hatari na athari za barabarani na jinsi ya kuziepuka.

Kaimu Afisa Usafirishaji Mkoa (RTO) Mrakibu Msaaidizi wa Polisi John Ntunde akihutubia halaiki hiyo alisisitiza kuwa bodaboda ndio chanzo kikuu cha ajali za barabarani katika kipindi cha miaka michache iliyopita. Wamekuwa wazembe sana na kusababisha ukiukwaji wa sheria za usalama barabarani. "Tumewakabidhi na kuwaamini madereva wa pikipiki jukumu kuwachukua watoto wetu kutoka sehemu moja hadi nyingine, inasikitisha sana hawajali na hawafati alama za barabarani na hivyo kuwa chanzo kikubwa cha ajali, tunawahitaji ninyi waendesha bodaboda muwe waangalifu na mhakikishe mnareshimu vivuko vya watembea kwa miguu, zingatia mwendo wako na muhimu zaidi wathamini haki ya kuishi ya watu wengine kwa kuzingatia sheria za usalama barabarani," alisema Mrakibu Msaaidizi Ntunde.

Programu maalum ya utendaji na usimamizi wa maktaba ilitengenezwa na kuwekwa kwenye maktaba hiyo; vitabu vya kielektroniki na mafunzo vilipakiwa kwenye tovuti ya shule. Vitabu vyote na nakala zake vikiwemo za vitabu vilivyochapishwa.

Katika maudhui haya, hii ni miongozo ya masomo na tamthiliya za Kiingereza na Kiswahili.

Kwa kutumia rasilimali za maktaba ya kielektroniki, wanafunzi wataweza kusoma na kutazama nyenzo za masomo, walimu wataweza kupakua na kubadilishana taarifa na mipango ya kuandaa masomo.

Kompyuta katika Shule ya Sekondari ya Msindo zimeunganishwa kwenye maktaba za kielektroniki za shule nyingine, hivyo wanafunzi na walimu wanapata fursa ya kushiriki katika mikutano ya mtandaoni na, hatimaye, kuzungumza.

Gharama zote za mradi zilifikia Shilingi za Kitanzania milioni 32.2. Mbali na gharama za maktaba yenyewe ya kielektroniki, kiasi hiki pia kilijumuisha ununuzi wa machapisho ili kuongeza hadhi na ufanisi wa maktaba.

Kwa kutengeneza mazingira rafiki ya kufanya kazi na ya kutia moyo shule hupewa zana za kujifunzia kwa ufanisi na kukuza utamaduni wa kujisomea. Katika kupata maktaba, wanafunzi hujisomea zaidi, hujifunza zaidi hivyo kwenda mbali zaidi katika masomo yao.

Mpango huu umefungua njia kwa wanafunzi na walimu kupata rasilimali za elimu zinazohitajika kwa ajili ya kuendeleza utamaduni wa kusoma.
